### How to instal fonts into your system:

Apple users:

1. Open a Finder window.
2. Select "Go" from the menu, press "alt" key to activate the "Library" option and select it.
3. A new window should appear on your screen. Open the "Fonts" folder
4. For installing the fonts you should just drag and drop the fonts in this folder.

Windows users:


1. Go to Control Panel.
2. Open the "Fonts" folder.
3. For installing the fonts you should just drag and drop the fonts in this folder.

## How to apply a brush on a shape


**Step 1:** Select a shape from the Logo\_Design\_Kit-Shapes.ai or simply create one your own and copy it to your working space.

**Step 2:** Open the Brush panel.


Go to the menu bar select Window / Brushes. You'll see that a panel will appear on the screen.



**Step 3:** Now you need to bring all your brushes in the Brushes panel. You can do that by clicking on the small list icons from the upper right part of the panel. Go to Open Brush Library and select Other Library. From the window that opens go to the main download folder, select Bushes and hit Open.




**Step 4:** Now you just need to apply the brush on the shape. First select the shape you brought from the Logo\_Design\_Kit-Shapes and with the shape selected click on a brush you want from the Brushes panel.




## How to Resize a brush

**Step 1:** If the leaves are too big for your design you can adjust them. You'll see that if you use a brush in your design it will appear in the main Brushes Panel. With your shape selected double click on the used brush from the main panel. A new window should appear.




**Step 2:** In order to adjust the leaves size you need to reduce the percentage of the brush and then hit OK and Apply to stroke



## How to flip the leaves directions


**Step 1:** With your shape selected double click on the used brush from the main panel.

A new window should appear. In order to adjust the leaves' direction you need to check Flip Along option. If you want to invert the brush you can select Flip Across option. After this you need to press Apply to stroke.




## How to Expand Appearance

**Step 1:** Now if you already have a brush added to a stroke, if you want to use this you need to expand it. Select the design and go to Object and Expand Appearance. Now you transformed the applied brush into a shape and you can use it as a stand alone design.




## How to make just a half laurel and flip it

**Step 1:** Delete half of the shape by deleting the anchor points from a side.




**Step 2:** Add an anchor point in the upper part of the remaining shape and delete the point that was in the middle.




**Step 3:** Expand the brush (Go to Menu and select Object / Expand Appearance, see previous explanations.)

**Step 4:** Now you need to reflect this existing shape. Do that by following these simple steps:


1. Select the Shape
2. Right click on it
3. Select Transform / Reflect



4. Select Vertical, 90° and then hit Copy.




Step 5: Lastly you just need to align the shapes and merge them.



**Step 6:** For merging the Shapes you need to open a new tool. Go to Window and select Pathfinder.

**Step 7:** Select the 2 shapes and press the first icon from the Pathfinder panel.
